
You can restrict use of the following features by adjusting the options in Parental Controls.

What is Picross?

Picross is a "picture crossword" puzzle game in which you complete a picture by filling in only certain squares. You puzzle out which squares to fill in by looking at hint numbers shown on the puzzle's top and left sides.



■ Rules and Features

● Time Limit

You'll get a time-over notice if you take longer than 60 minutes to complete a puzzle. You can continue playing after 60 minutes have passed, but the final picture will not be shown in color.

● Answer Autocheck

When turned on, this feature will correct any squares you fill in incorrectly. You will receive a time penalty for each mistake, however.

● Hint Number Autocheck Feature

When turned on, this feature will gray out any hint numbers that have been settled.

● Hint Roulette

You will be asked whether you want to use this feature before starting a puzzle. The roulette will start if you select "Yes." Tap the lower screen or press Ⓐ to stop the roulette, which will display the answers for that row and column.

◆ You can turn these functions on and off in the game settings, which are accessible from the title screen (page 8).

You can change your control method for solving puzzles in the settings.

Stylus Controls

You can use your stylus to select options, icons, squares, and more.

- ◆ Right-handed players can press up or down on \oplus/\odot to switch between filling in squares or marking them with an "x." Left-handed players can use \otimes and \textcircled{B} to do the same.

Button Controls

You can use buttons to select options, icons, squares, and more.

Select option / move cursor	\oplus/\odot
Confirm / fill in a square	\textcircled{A}
Cancel / mark with "x"	\textcircled{B}
Switch pages / enable or disable navigation feature	\boxed{L}/\boxed{R}

Saving Data

Picross and Mega Picross

Press  and then select Suspend to save your current progress and return to the title screen. You can create one set of quick-save data, which you can select later from the title menu.

Micross

Press  and then select Suspend to save your progress and return to the Micross puzzle-selection screen. Progress for each puzzle within the Micross puzzle will be saved.

Erasing Data

Select Clear Save Data on the settings screen to erase all save data and reset the game.

◆ Please be careful when erasing data. Erased data cannot be restored.

Data can be lost due to user action, such as repeatedly powering off and on the system or removing a Game Card or SD Card while saving. Data loss may also be caused by poor connectivity due to dirt or dust in the system's ports. Please be aware that in these cases data cannot be restored.

1 How to Play

Learn how to solve Picross, Mega Picross, or Micross puzzles.

2 Picross

There are a myriad of puzzles for everyone from beginners to experienced players to enjoy.

3 Mega Picross

These puzzles have rules for more experienced players involving Mega Numbers, which are numbers that cross over rows or columns.

4 Micross

Complete an elaborate picture by solving puzzles within squares you've filled in.

- ◆ For this mode, Answer Autocheck is turned off.

5 Miiverse

Connect to Miiverse and post messages or pictures using stamps.


6 Settings

From this menu, you can change your control method, turn some features on and off, and adjust sound options. You can also erase your save data.

Puzzle Selection

From the title screen, choose Picross, Mega Picross, or Micros to proceed to the puzzle-selection menu for that mode.

**1 Picture**

The final picture is displayed.

2 Title

The title for the puzzle.

3 ID

The number of the puzzle.

4 Size

The size of the puzzle.

5 Clear Time

Displays how long it took to solve the puzzle.

6 Page Navigation Buttons

Each page displays 15 puzzles. Tap the buttons or press **L/R** to change pages.

7 Miiverse

You can post a screenshot of the upper screen to Miiverse.

Micross Puzzle Selection



When solving a Micross puzzle, you'll start by playing on the Overall Puzzle. Once you have completed the Overall Puzzle, the filled-in squares will turn into , which you can select to play a Micro Puzzle.

1 Miiverse


You can post a screenshot of the upper screen to Miiverse.

2 Play from Start

Use this to reset a Micross puzzle and start over.

10 Puzzle Screen

The puzzle screen shown in the example is for Stylus Controls.



1 Picture

Displays current state of the picture.

2 ID

The number of the current puzzle.

3 Elapsed Time

If the elapsed time exceeds 60 minutes, you'll get a time-over notice.

4 Control Mode

This will function only when using stylus controls. You can switch between filling in squares and marking them with an "x."

5 Navigation

This is a useful feature that points out rows or columns where it's possible to fill in or mark a square based on your current progress. The numbers in these rows or columns will turn blue. Tap  or press / to enable or disable this feature.

6 Pause Menu

You can stop working on a puzzle or change your control method at any time. Tap  or press  to access the pause menu.
