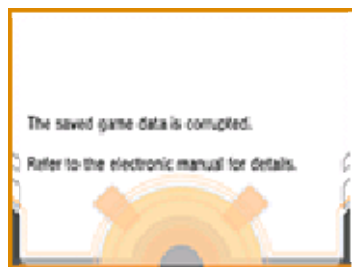

● About Saving Your Data

You cannot save your progress partway through your adventure. Your play data will be automatically saved after you have seen the ending movie. If you would like to stop playing temporarily, please put your Nintendo 3DS system into Sleep Mode.

- ◆ The Special Demo Version's saved data cannot be erased.
- ◆ The saved data can be copied or moved to another SD Card, but it cannot be used as back-up data.

● If Your Saved Data Becomes Unusable



If you cannot save your game, you will not be able to return to the title screen. When you see the above

screen, press \oplus + \textcircled{B} + \textcircled{X} simultaneously and follow the directions that appear on-screen.

Data can be lost due to user action, such as repeatedly powering off and on the system or removing a Game Card or SD Card while saving. Data loss may also be caused by poor connectivity due to dirt or dust in the system's ports. Please be aware that in these cases data cannot be restored.



Starting the Game



Once you have selected your preferred language, you will continue to the title screen. You cannot switch languages after saving your game. Press **START** on the title screen, and the game will begin.

The Field Menu

If you press \otimes while in the field, the screen below will be displayed.



1 Pokémon

View information about the Pokémon in your party, change their order, give them items, and more.

2 Bag



View your items and use them from here. You can also change the order in which your Pockets appear by holding the stylus down on an icon and moving it.



About BuzzNav



You can watch BuzzNav on the lower screen. You can see information about and controls for Pokémon Omega Ruby and Pokémon Alpha Sapphire on BuzzNav.



5 The Battle Screen

Understanding the Battle Screen

When a battle starts, the Pokémon shown on the top left of the Pokémon screen in the field menu will appear in battle first. All Pokémon taking part in a battle can gain Experience Points if you win or succeed in capturing the wild Pokémon. However, a fainted Pokémon cannot gain Exp. Points. If all of your Pokémon faint, you'll lose the battle and be returned to Steven's location.



- ① Name, Gender, and Level of Opposing Pokémon
- ② Opposing Pokémon's HP
HP is the measurement of a Pokémon's health. When it reaches zero, the Pokémon faints and can no longer do battle.
- ③ Number of Opposing Pokémon
- ④ Number of Pokémon in Your Party
- ⑤ Your Pokémon's HP
- ⑥ Name, Gender, and Level of Your Pokémon
- ⑦ Experience Points Gauge

When the gauge is filled up, your Pokémon gains a level.



8 Fight

Direct your Pokémon to use its moves. The number of times you can use a given move is listed as Power Points (PP). When a move's PP reaches zero, it cannot be used again until its PP is restored.

9 Bag

Use some of the items in your Bag.

10 Run

Flee from a battle. Attempting to run away does not always succeed, and you cannot run from a battle against another Trainer.

11 Pokémon

Check information about Pokémon in your party, and switch them in and out of battle.



You can send Pokémon you caught or items you received to the full version of Pokémon Omega Ruby or Pokémon Alpha Sapphire. Note that you must watch the ending movie once before you can send anything.

- ◆ The items you can send will change depending on how many times you have seen the ending movie.
- ◆ You can only send a Pokémon or item selection from the Special Demo Version to the full version of Pokémon Omega Ruby or Pokémon Alpha Sapphire once per day.
- ◆ In order to receive a Pokémon in the full version of the game, you'll need to have received a Pokédex in the full version.

You will need the Nintendo 3DS system that you use to play Pokémon Omega Ruby or Pokémon Alpha Sapphire, so have it ready.

- ◆ Please do not remove the SD Card from your Nintendo 3DS system.



Start the Special Demo Version on the same Nintendo 3DS system that you use to play your full version of

the game. Talk to Steven in front of the Pokémon Center, and select "Send to full game."



Please read the explanation and select what you want to send to your full version of the game.



To receive the items or Pokémon you sent to your full version of the game, select Pokémon Link in the title menu of the full version.
